The new MHC handle has been developed by the Italian entity of the Group, the center of excellence for the remote controls range. The new handle has been designed to host in a compact space a wide number of controls, like for example the new electro-proportional roller, entirely developed in-house, as well as the full range of switches and devices available on Hydreco handles.
